

To Users of TheraManager on a network using a peer-to-peer "Server" with Windows XP Service Pack 2 installed

After installing the recently released Windows XP Service Pack 2 on your Server, the new and much more comprehensive fire-wall will be set as the default and you will not be able to login into TheraManager over the network, or the internet if you use this service.

Please do not call us in a panic but change the settings as described below.

To Enable a LAN with Windows XP-SP2 Firewall enabled on the Server

- Click Start Button
- Click Control Panel
- Click Windows Firewall
- Select Exceptions Tab
- Click Add Port
 - Enter any name eg. 'Advantage 2000 TCP'
 - Enter port number 2000
 - Make sure that TCP is bulleted.
 - Click 'OK'.
- Click Add Port
 - Enter new name eg. 'Advantage 2000 UDP'
 - Enter port number 2000
 - Make sure that UDP is bulleted.
 - Click 'OK'.
- Click "OK".
- Now open c:\Program Files\Extended Systems\Advantage\Server\ads_cfg.exe
- Select **Configuration Utility Tab**
- Select **Communications Tab**
- Set IP Port = 2000
- Click Apply
- Restart the Advantage Server after ensuring that all open TheraManager programs on the network are closed.

To Re-enable Internet Access with Windows XP-SP2 Firewall enabled on the Server

(This feature can be purchased from TheraManager Software Inc)

- Click Start Button
- Click Control Panel
- Click Windows Firewall
- Select Exceptions Tab
- Click Add Port

- Enter any name eg. 6262 TCP
 - Enter port number 6262
 - Make sure that TCP is bulleted.
 - Click 'OK'.
- Click Add Port
 - Enter new name eg. 6262 UDP
 - Enter port number 6262
 - Make sure that UDP is bulleted.
 - Click 'OK'.
- Click "OK".
- Now open c:\Program Files\Extended Systems\Advantage\Server\ads_cfg.exe
- Select **Configuration Utility Tab**
- Select **Communications Tab**
- Set Internet Port = 6262
- Click Apply
- Restart the Advantage Server after ensuring that all open TheraManager programs on the network are closed.
